Lack of services (e.g. schools, healthcare)	Better work opportunities
Being unsafe	Better services (e.g. school or health care)
Poverty	Safer, with less crime
High levels of crime	To be nearer family or friends
Crops failing	Political stability
Disasters (e.g. earthquakes, flooding or drought)	More fertile land for growing crops
Conflict	Less risk from disasters (e.g. drought, earthquakes or flooding)
